As part of the **Core team** we expect:

- Mature Christian
- Team player
- Flexible attitude
- Responsible
- Able to communicate with other leaders
- Willing to share their Faith
- Willing to help in areas other than designated responsibility (tasks that are dull or dirty such as cleanup, moving, etc.)

Training:

- Core Team move in day is on June 10 at 8:00am. This is to complete core team training and day camp preparations.
- Camps start the first week of July.

The service:

- Work as a team to help lead day camps in Belize City
- motivate and empower other Belizean Youth to put their faith into action.
- take initiative in building relationships
- intentionally encouraging those you are working with
- Accountability when necessary
- setting a good example in attitude and work ethic, and guiding local youth as they assist you in your assigned area.

Living in Community:

- You will be residing with the Core team on the BCE base located on 4.5 Miles George Price Highway
- Along with your house mates you will be responsible for the cleaning and up keep of your home and personal space
- You will have to share a house/bathroom/shower/toilet with others
- We have a kitchen and cooks who will provide yummy meals every day
- Respect peoples personal space
- Label belongings
- Take care of ministry property that is entrusted to you

Spiritual Growth

- Leaders are encouraged to have a personal devotion time with the lord
- Willing to share testimonies with others
- Help lead other volunteers in a time of devotionals

Some things to be aware of:

The City:

It will be worthwhile for you do some research into the situation in which you will be ministering. I challenge you to keep up with some of the Belizean news as you prepare to come to Belize.

Check out: http://amandala.com.bz/news/ Please do not let the stories frighten you. We will not take you to any place that we ourselves would not feel safe taking our own child. We play it safe and do not go out at night, when most of the trouble happens and are always very cautious. But you need to be aware of what is going on. Because those stories in the paper that might worry you, this is what our children deal with every day. The children who witness these events and live through these situations, these are the kids we are reaching with the Good News of the Love of Jesus.

The Children:

Most of them come from single mother homes or live with their grandmother, with many brothers and sisters from different fathers. Many have been witness and maybe subject to physical or even sexual abuse.

Most of the kids we work with are poor, and may not have any food to eat at home. These kids need love, and affirmation, but they also need structure and discipline. So don't be surprised when we correct them, or even send them home at times. They always have the opportunity to come back and be a part of the group, but they have to learn to obey authority and live in harmony with each other. Some of these kids' fathers or brothers are involved in gangs, which can create problems (fighting, name calling, etc.) between kids at camp whose families are involved in opposing gangs.

The Climate:

The time of year you will be here, the temperature will be HOT and HUMID, as summer time is our RAINY SEASON. It is also our HURRICANE season. Hurricanes are rare but we will make arrangements and keep provisions just in case of an emergency as we did have Hurricane Earl hit Belize last year, nonetheless, we will take good care of you.

The Creatures:

Come prepared for mosquitos and sand flies. Your best defense against these is bug repellent LOTION. For some reason we find the lotion works most effective.

Be aware that at some time or another you may see or come in contact with the following creatures in your house: geckos, small (nonpoisonous) spiders, bees, roaches, ticks, and ants. Lizards, fish, stingrays, snakes and others tropical creatures are a common sight around Belize and you may even see them in our yard or beach.

The Camps:

Camps are day camps run throughout Belize City, in parks, schoolyards, churches, and even backyards. Most of the camps happen on Belize City's "South Side." Sometimes there isn't much shade or shelter space to work with, but we make it work. Especially considering that it's rainy season, we often have to be creative and come up with "plan B" on the spot, so be ready to be flexible. The days are long and tiring, but richly rewarding.

The Food:

At camp we feed the children snacks of fruit and cookies, and for full day camps, we sometimes offer the children lunch. Lunch's served are all from donated goods, so be prepared to eat a lot of the same things at camp – rice and beans and chicken or ground beef. Be prepared to eat what you're served with a thankful heart and a smile.
